Wednesday January 8, 2025

12:00 p.m. We will start allowing tractors IN THE PIT AREA for the THURSDAY AFTERNOON SESSION, THURSDAY EVENING, and FRIDAY AFTERNOON ONLY!!!!! When you arrive at the facility, there will be someone to park you in an orderly fashion. You will have a map enclosed in your puller packet. That map will give you the designated area you are assigned to park. Please park in your assigned area. These assignments are based on your hauler length and you will 100 % contaminate the success of our parking process for everyone following you if you decide to do so. After you have parked your hauler come into the REGISTRATION AREA, located on the southwest side of the building, with ALL of your crew and pick up all passes for the weekend. After you have registered and your crew has their passes then we are ready for you to unload your tractor. Please have your PULLING POSITION NUMBER ON THE FRONT OF YOUR TRACTOR AS SOON AS YOU UNLOAD IT. THIS IS VERY !!!! VERY !!!! IMPORTANT TO DETERMINE WHERE YOU ARE GOING TO BE PARKED ONCE YOU ARE BROUGHT INTO THE BUILDING. PLEASE DO NOT PUT ON YOUR EXHAUST PIPE ON IN THE PARKING LOT. THIS NEEDS TO BE INSPECTED BY A WHATSSMOKIN TECH OFFICIAL BEFORE IT IS PUT ON YOUR TURBOCHARGER. "LIGHT" support vehicle traffic will be allowed. This means if you want to bring in your exhaust pipe, heaters, generators, and etc. you may do so with your GATOR -KUBOTA- MULE- ETC. Be very conscious about where you park you support vehicle for the time you have it in the building, so you are NOT blocking traffic lanes and you ARE NOT taking up spaces around that other pullers need to be parked in. After your gear is inside, the support vehicle needs to go back outside and back into your hauler. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

6:00 p.m. We will allow 20 test passes. These tractors have pre-registered for these test passes . If you have pre-registered to make a test pass make sure you are ready to pull by 6:00 p.m.

Thursday January 9, 2025

8:30 a.m. We will continue staging tractors for the THURSDAY AFTERNOON SESSION and THURSDAY EVENING, and FRIDAY AFTERNOON SESSION IN THE PIT AREA. PLEASE DO NOT PUT ON YOUR EXHAUST PIPE ON IN THE PARKING LOT. THIS NEEDS TO BE INSPECTED BY A WHATSSMOKIN TECH OFFICIAL BEFORE IT IS PUT ON YOUR TURBOCHARGER. LIGHT support vehicle traffic will be You don't have to weigh the tractor when you come into the pit area. You will be weighed before you enter the warm up area and then staged behind the sled.

8:30 a.m. TECH WILL START ON EACH CLASS COMPETING THURSDAY AFTERNOON. Please have your tractor ready for inspection. ALL pullers make sure you have your exhaust pipe off and have your turbocharger ready for inspection on BOTH INTAKE and EXHAUST sides. After your initial exhaust side inspection, upon approval, and you don't change your turbo charger for any reason, you will not have to take off the exhaust side the rest of the weekend. Make sure someone is with your tractor during this time. If you don't get teched you don't pull.

9:30 a.m. DRIVER'S MEETING FOR BOTH SESSIONS will be held in the first set of bleachers on the northwest side of the building. After the driver's meeting is over the first class, 9,000 lb. Pro Farm, will start to be staged and we will start the afternoon show at 11:00 a.m. sharp!!! We ask all pullers to be ready when we come to you. We have several tractors to pull each day, so please work with us to keep the show flowing and we will get done in a timely fashion each session. After you have completed your pull and your class is over, if you DID NOT make the finals, prepare your tractor to leave the pit area and be loaded into your hauler. If you are no longer competing the rest of the weekend please move your hauler to your hotel parking lot if possible or the secured area at the truck stop. Please do this voluntarily. Please! Please! Please!, Don't try to manipulate the system, to prevent moving your hauler. That will destroy the flow of the parking lot, and hurt the show. This will also prevent us from accepting your application at future Whatssmokin events. We really appreciate your cooperation.

If you are pulling in another class, please have your new number card on your tractor after you are done pulling. Please do this in a timely fashion, be considerate to your fellow pullers and the tow tractor operators. Prize money will be available within an hour of the completion of each class.
